Why Love + One?

- In remote Uganda, there is no 911. People in remote Ugandan villages are isolated from resources many of us take for granted. Love+One works to connect children and their families with life-saving care, no matter where they live.
- Love+One offers parents support. A seriously ill child is a frightening challenge for all parents, whether the family lives in a major city or small village. Love+One works to make sure Ugandan parents know help is available, no matter how dire the situation or remote the location.
- Care doesn't end after the emergency. Love+One works with families and communities to help ensure ongoing access to preventative care, educational resources, and more.
- The Love+One Center provides on-site care. Through a four-step process spanning assessment, rehabilitation, resettlement, and follow-ups, the Love+One Center offers a space for seriously ill children to come receive life-saving care, then continues to serve as a shepherding point of contact.
- In 2007, Mike and Suzanne Mayernick traveled to Uganda to bring home their new daughter, JosieLove. When they arrived, they discovered three-and-a-half-year-old JosieLove weighed just 15 pounds and was suffering from complicated health crises. After just a few months of sustained care she needed back, JosieLove was thriving—and Suzanne knew she had to intervene to help Ugandan children. Love+One International was born.

Through constant communication with strategically placed community liaisons, Love+One helps secure emergency and ongoing medical services for children suffering from serious conditions ranging from malaria, HIV, and tuberculosis, to malnourishment and more. Love+One's mission is personal. The organization was founded by Mike and Suzanne Mayernick after the couple adopted their three-year-old daughter, JosieLove, from Uganda. JosieLove had urgent medical needs prompted by malaria, tuberculosis and being HIV positive, and the Mayernicks learned quickly that she was not alone. By utilizing a comprehensive spectrum of support spanning critical care, rehabilitative care, and community care, Love+One is on a mission to transform the hearts of children and families through life-saving medical care, family preservation and sharing the love of Jesus.
